



House Rules of Lebanon Lodge # 422

Membership Cards – All members are required to use their key card to gain admission to the lodge and to exhibit their membership card when asked to do so. No one is permitted to loan their card for entrance to the lodge to anyone else.

Children – Children are permitted in the lodge only while under direct supervision of an adult. No one under twenty-one years of age is permitted in the card room or to sit at the bar.

Dues – A member whose dues are delinquent will be denied the privileges of the clubroom. Dues are to be paid by March 31 unless other arrangements are made.

Profanity – Profane and abusive language in the clubroom will not be tolerated.

Alcohol – No outside alcoholic beverages shall be brought on the premises for consumption in violation of the State of Ohio Liquor Laws.

Employees – Harassment of employees will not be tolerated. Individual members do not have the authority to reprimand employees of the Elks. All complaints must be brought before the Board of Directors.

Guests – Guest are not permitted in the lodge unless accompanied by an Elk member and must leave when the member leaves. The member must have the guest sign in on the guest register. Guests are not permitted to buy drinks. The member is responsible for the conduct of the guest. Members are permitted to bring guest living outside the jurisdiction of the Lebanon Lodge # 422 to any club function unless announced as Members Only. Persons living in the jurisdiction of our Lodge are permitted to be guest a maximum of three (3) times. This rule is to be policed by the member and subject to review by the Board of Directors.

Bar- No one except authorized persons will be permitted behind the bar. The person in charge and / or the bartender on duty has the right to deny service to or request a member and / or their guest to leave the premises if their conduct warrants such actions.

Lodge Property – All members are responsible to maintain a clean and orderly lodge. Lodge property may not be removed from the lodge without written consent of the Board of Directors. The person responsible will pay for any willful or malicious destruction of lodge property. If person responsible is a member they may be subject to disciplinary action by the Board of Directors.

Operation & Management – The operation, management, and control of home and club occupied by this lodge shall be supervised and conducted by the Board of Directors. The Board of Directors of the lodge shall have the power to suspend a member from Club Room privileges for any violation of house rules, after notice to such member and a hearing before the Board of Directors. The decision of the Board of Directors on any question involving interpretation of any house rules shall be final.
